  - Current Retail prices are dependent on menu item(s) selected. The average price per meal is addressed in Question 42. According to the Fall 2023 Survey, 52% listed pricing as a "common dislike."
- 29. Is there meal participation from the workforce training program? If so, what is estimated participation (revenue or meal counts)?
  - There is no current participation from our outreach centers, including the Parker Technical Education Center or the Workforce Training Center.
- 30. Are there future projected changes in overall student numbers on campus or other program involvement?
  - Decrease in student enrollment mitigated by an increase in recruitment and retention efforts. A change in Athletic affiliation to the NJCAA may increase participation in our Dining program as our student athletes will be the recipients of scholarship funding.
- 31. Section 4.A.17 requests implementation of services at non-main campus locations. What sites are in reference and please describe desired services at these locations (i.e. daily catering, grab n' go dining options, special event catering, etc.). Is this also in reference to the future consideration projects?
  - Site referenced includes specifically the Parker Technical Education Center.
     There are approximately 150 students plus 30 faculty/staff Monday through
     Friday. Desired services may initially include coffee service and breakfast and lunch options, including grab n'go options. Event catering has been historically serviced as needed with preparation primarily at the main campus kitchen.
- 32. There are culinary students on campus. Are they open to a paid internship program?
  - NIC Dining Services has occasionally employed NIC culinary students. Paid internships are attractive. The challenge is aligning student schedules with operational needs.
- 33. Please clarify the current and/or desired role of the two college employees working in the food service operation. Please provide wage rates for these two employees.
  - The two college employees are 1) Barista and 2) Cook. The expectation by the college is for these two employees to remain in those roles. The hourly wage for each = \$21.39.
- 34. What is the current staffing pattern for the Caffeinated Cardinal and hours of operation?
  - Caffeinated Cardinal hours of operation: Monday through Thursday (7:30 am 4:00 pm) and Friday (7:30 am 2:00pm). Staffing includes one Barista per shift currently one full-time and one-part time.
